

SIGNS OF STROKE

A stroke is a brain injury caused by a disruption of blood flow to the brain. There are two main types of stroke: ischemic and hemorrhagic. An ischemic stroke occurs when a blood vessel is blocked and stops blood flow to a part of the brain. A hemorrhagic stroke is caused by bleeding on the brain tissue, which may form a clot and stop blood flow.

Dizziness

Loss of balance
