An American worker is injured every 7 seconds.

What to do if you are injured at work

- Report any on-the-job injuries to your supervisor immediately.
- If emergency medical care is needed, initial treatment may occur at the first available medical facility.
- Work with Human Resources to file Oregon Form 801, the Worker's and Employer's Report of Occupational Injury or Disease/Illness.
- If you seek medical treatment for your injury, tell your doctor you were hurt on the job and work to complete Oregon Form 827, Worker's and Physician's Report for Workers' Compensation Claims.
- Employer and medical providers must report job-related injuries to your employer's workers' compensation insurer.
