Schedule II Narcotics: Oxycodone, Hydrocodone/Norco, Percocet, Dilaudid, Lortab

Schedule III Narcotics: Tramadol, Tylenol with Codeine

Tylenol (over-the-counter): Maximum dose = 1,000 mg three times a day

Anti-inflammatories (over-the-counter): Ibuprofen, Advil, Aleve, Naprosyn, Meloxicam (these should not be used until approved by your surgeon)

Muscle Relaxers: Robaxin/Methocarbamol, Cyclobenzaprine/Flexeril

Nerve pain medications: Gabapentin, Lyrica

- > Pain medication refills are at the discretion of your surgeon and the above is a general guideline.
- > ALL prescription refill requests require 24-48 hour notice.
- > No refills will be made on Fridays.
